<b><i>Cabernet Sauvignon</i></b>		
<b>Liberty School, Paso Robles, CA (USA)</b>	<b>14</b>	<b>53</b>
<i>Aromas of warm vanilla, fresh currants, dark fruit, savory herbs and clean bright acidity finish with lingering sweet oak</i>		
<b>Stonestreet estate vineyards, CA (USA)</b>		<b>75</b>
<i>The palate offers dark, savory flavors of black currant, dried cherry, dried Herbes de Provence, and a touch of vanilla bean, enveloped in fine tannins that extend the wine through a lengthy cocoa-powder</i>		
<b><i>Pinot Noir</i></b>		
<b>Estancia pinot noir, CA (USA)</b>	<b>12</b>	<b>45</b>
<i>Light and perfumed with cherries, raspberry's and strawberry on the nose and palate, concentrated flavors and a lingering finish make this a fabulous Pinot Noir choice</i>

<i>High-pitched red berry and candied rose scents are complemented by suggestions of rhubarb, white pepper and underbrush. Shows good energy and lift to the subtly sweet raspberry and floral pastille flavors</i>

<i>Incredible aromas of chamomile, hibiscus, fruit tea, lavender, dried strawberries, cherries, lemons and light white chocolate. Medium-bodied</i>

<b>The Prisoner, Napa Valley, CA (USA)</b>		<b>130</b>
<i>Full bodied Napa Bordeaux blend mix of Cabernet Sauvignon, Petite Sirah, Syrah, and Charbono. Ripe dark fruits – cherries, blackberries – give way to tobacco and chocolate flavors on the palate. Well balanced and highly lauded featuring 3 times on Wine Spectator's Top 100 list</i>		

<b><i>Burgundy</i></b>		
<b>Jean-Baptiste Ponsot, Rully (France)</b>		<b>75</b>
<i>Aromatic, fresh and delicate with lovely, red berry fruit. From south of the Cote D'Or, this wine offers a great quality and good structure</i>		

<b><i>Chianti Classico</i></b>		
<b>Villa a Sesta Sangiovese, Tuscany (Italy)</b>		<b>49</b>
<i>Classic wine of a deep ruby red colour with violet reflexes and an intense bouquet rich in fruity aromas such as cherry and blackberry</i>		
<b>Brunello di Montalcino Tuscany (Italy)</b>		<b>109</b>
<i>Brilliant red with burgundy reflects. Wild black fruits, black cherry and noble wood on the nose. Great body &amp; elegance; warm, dry and persistent</i>

<b><i>Sauvignon blanc</i></b>		
<b>Wente Sauvignon Blanc, CA (USA)</b>	<b>11</b>	<b>45</b>
<i>From one of the oldest family-owned wineries in the USA, fresh aromatics from flint, guava to wet stone minerality, balanced by notes of mandarin and lime zest</i>		
<b><i>Pinot Grigio</i></b>		
<b>WillaKenzie Estate Pinot gris (Grigio), OR (USA)</b>		
<i>This Pinot Gris is complex and expressive, offering notes of citrus blossom, honeydew melon, Asian pear and hints of minerality. This wine is fresh and vibrant but sufficiently creamy to achieve wonderful harmony and balance</i>		
<b>Barone Fini Valdadige, (Italy)</b>	<b>12</b>	<b>46</b>
<i>100% hand harvested grapes are selected from esteemed wine producing region of Valdadige located in the pristine northern Italian Alps. This Pinot Grigio showcases aromas of floral and lemon mist with ripe juicy flavors of honeydew and apple filling the mouth. Bright acidity balanced with warm minerality create a lingering crisp finish.</i>		
<b>Antinori Toscana "Villa Antinori"(Italy)</b>	<b>12</b>	<b>46</b>
<i>Fruity and floral, offers much finesse and elegance with notes of bananas, pineapple, white flowers, and candied fruit. The palate is balanced with a good persistence and savory mineral notes on the finish and aftertaste</i>

<i>Pale golden in colour fresh, well-developed bouquet with aromas of white-fleshed fruit and a hint of white flowers</i>		
<b><i>Sancerre</i></b>		
<b>Pascal Jolivet Sancerre, Loire Valley (France)</b>		<b>72</b>
<i>This sancerre is graceful and restrained, displaying the dry and flinty minerality one finds in the better French wines, complemented by a vibrant, citrus-edged finish. A masterful expression</i>		
<b><i>Chardonnay</i></b>		
<b>Les Cottes Chardonnay (France)</b>	<b>10</b>	<b>40</b>
<i>Les Cottes is the fruit of rigor in the choice of origins allows a unique creation, authentic and of great finesse. The delicate expression of the fruit is sublimated by its great purity, freshness and a good concentration</i>		
<b>La Crema, Sonoma Coast, CA (USA)</b>		
<i>Aromas of Meyer lemon, Gala apple, and subtle hints of OAK are followed by flavors of white stone fruit, yellow plum, and honeydew melon</i>

<i>Pale salmon pink with an orange hue; very fresh nose of grapefruit and minerals; dry, some acidity, hint of strawberry and candy floss at the finish</i>

<i>A gentle and elegant style with soft acidity and notes of ripe apple. Well balanced and harmonious through to the long finish</i>		
<b>Veuve Clicquot Champagne (France)</b>		<b>150</b>
<i>Vuevu Clicquot Yellow Label manages to reconcile two opposing factors - strength and silkiness - and to hold them in perfect balance with aromatic intensity and a lot of freshness</i>

<i>Dry floral and fresh, with fine delicate bubbles and a refreshing clean aftertaste. An all-round Prosecco to be enjoyed with any type of dish or just by itself</i>		
<b>Bortolomiol Prosecco 'Miol' Veneto (Italy)</b>	<b>11</b>	<b>44</b>
<i>Delicate but enticing scents of white spring flower and pear waft out of the glass. On the refreshing palate, vibrant acidity and small continuous beads underscore yellow apple, lemon zest and a hint of white pear</i>
